CANOE CREEK NATURE TRAIL

The approximately 2.1-mile main trail along the creek is an extension of a short asphalt trail in Newman Park. There is another mile of accessory trails.

The route has a few foot bridges traversing ditches and streams feeding into Canoe Creek. The trail has changes in elevation that make it a moderate hiking experience.

The trail allows hikers to trek alongside Canoe Creek, observe the flora and fauna of wetlands and have access to an outdoor classroom providing a good learning location for Scout troops and science students.

Funding for the trail was provided by the City of Henderson Parks and Recreation Department and the Kentucky Department of Local Government Recreational Trails Program.
